- 1. This year's election occurred in early March. Roughly 100 members voted (roughly 1/2 of our membership). Positions for election include vice president and one new member to the executive board. We thank Tiago Mata and Evelyn Forget for their service and welcome José Edwards (Exec) and Maria Pia Paganelli (VP) to the Executive Committee.
- 2. Membership is down from previous years, but this is most likely due to (a) the virtual conference in 2020, (b) the delayed conference in 2021, and (c) other ongoing pandemic effects.

One important issue discussed in the Executive meeting this week is what we can do to make membership more attractive. We anticipate adding the option for automatic membership renewal to website along with changing memberships to a 365-day membership rather than calendar-year membership. We also plan to make the benefits of membership more visible on the website and to promote membership on most HES messages and at events.
